Art and Craft

Discover the wonderful world of art and craft. Through these courses you will find out how to choose a project, identify the materials you need, write, or draw, a plan of how you will do your art project, then enjoy making it! Enjoy trying out paints, chalks, crayons, acrylics, tracing paper, card thick or thin, sugar paper, tissue, and so on. Mix paints to create colours, draw, and sketch. You'll also learn how to keep tidy, store art equipment, and more.

In our cookery courses you will learn to cook simple snacks like savoury toasties, and pasta; plan a menu; understand the nutritional elements of a meal; and prepare a full course meal. If baking is your thing, sign up to one of our baking courses and bring to life your ideas for cakes and all things delicious. Not only will you get to make a range of different types of cakes you will enjoy trying out new decorating techniques and bake lots of cakes for different occasions.

Coffee shop management

Look no further to find out how to set up and serve at our in-house FitzRoy coffee shop. This is a great way to learn more about working in a café, serving coffee and tea, staying safe, keeping your kitchen area clean, and gaining confidence. You'll have fun preparing different types of drinks, handling money, and serving customers, in a safe and supportive environment.

Get to grips with computers

Find your way around the wonderful world of computers. Once you are feeling confident you will learn how to switch the computer on, log on, load a disc, use a computer safely, and close programmes before you shut the computer down. Keeping safe when using a computer is important, and we will show you how to follow rules to help you. Explore the internet, use search engines, look things up, play games, and share games, and finish with a project of your own choosing.

Discover new ways to communicate

Create a communication system that suits you! By joining this course you will learn more about using words, signs, phrases, objects, photographs, P.E.C.S, or Makaton symbols to communicate. Learn how to develop a communication board to help you recognise people and say good morning, and practice listening and respond to other people within the group, engage in discussion with other people by using your preferred method of communication, such Makaton or P.E.C.S.

Environment – Asdan module

Be inspired to get involved in the outdoors as you work through the Asdan booklet. Activities include painting sheds, building a bird box, recycling different items, upcycling a photo frame, or even a chair, visiting parks, and filling in in worksheets as you evidence all your learning.

Love History!

History is all around us, local history, ancient history, modern history, world history, and more. Join one of our history courses and choose a time in history you're interested in and get ready to explore it. You will learn how an era got its name, how people lived, what they wore, what they ate, and how their lives differed to yours.

Horticulture – Asdan module

Study and learn as you go with our Horticultural Asdan course. Modules include planning what to plant, and where, sowing seeds, pricking out, potting, taking cuttings, pruning, pest control, watering, feeding, weeding, composting, harvesting, cut flowers, maintaining tools, health and safety in the garden, and art activities with a horticultural theme.







John Muir Award

We're pleased to be able to offer you the chance of taking part in the John Muir Award. This includes a wide range of varied activities, such as, woodland walks, recognising trees, pressing flowers, making mallets, putting up hammocks, wood splitting, fire lighting skills, making jewellery, making nettle tea, pond dipping, and more.

Keep fit with seated exercises

With a bit of determination everyone can keep fit and healthy. This group is inclusive and gives you an opportunity for gentle exercise while your seated, plus enjoy team sports like basketball. After warm up exercises learn how to follow and maintain correct posture in a seated position. Follow the steps to a good posture, experience exercise using different equipment. Find out how a balanced diet can keep you healthy.

Know your community

Wherever you live there will be fascinating things to discover. Find out how your town got its name, if any famous people lived there and the stories they had to tell. Learning how to research and record facts is a very useful skill and helps you feel more connected to your community. By the end of the course you will have created a personal project about your town, found out about events going on and things you could get involved in, and explored your library and other community networks.

Maintenance

It takes a lot of work keeping an outdoor space, such as a garden, clean, safe, tidy, and flourishing. At our Rural Skills project you will learn about maintaining the paths, flower beds, and grounds. This includes raking, clearing, cutting back, weeding, sweeping, cleaning the fish points, making kindling out of sticks, chopping logs, cutting grass, and turning over the flower beds. You'll go home satisfied after a day of fun while you work.







Money wise

Looking after your money, planning for expenses, and creating a budget are very useful skills when you are learning to be more independent. Join a FitzRoy Money Wise course and you will gain confidence in many areas; planning a budget for a day out, recognising and counting money, creating a holiday budget, and learning skills to manage your money when food shopping. Learn how to save money in the future and keep your money safe.

Passionate about music

If you love music this course is for you. Indulge your passion and start learning about different genres, i.e. Rock and Roll, Rock, Classical, Opera, Blues, Reggae, Soul etc. You'll learn more about music from around the world, different traditions that include dance and new instruments, and express yourself through the instruments as you enjoy playing tunes in a group.

Explore nature and the environment

Nature and the environment are ever changing and there are many fascinating things to learn. You will learn about the seasons, farming, and what grows when and where. Enjoy becoming a Nature Detective and find out about different fungi that grows in this country, where and when they appear, and whether they are a source of food for wildlife. Get creative with your discoveries and create a wildlife project as you research life cycles, habitats, food, and more, using pictures and drawings wherever possible.

Create with needlecraft and sewing

A world of creative craft awaits you and we'll teach you how to be safe when using scissors, knives, needles, and a sewing machine. There is so much to make and create once you've learnt all about stitching, running stitch, back stitch, and cross stitch. You will get used to following instructions, when to start, when to stop, and find out how to make an apron, tablecloth, tea towel, or bag for example. Book now and delight someone by making them a present, or make your own decorations.

Out and about

We offer fantastic opportunities for you to explore new places. Plan a visit to a place of interest such as Staunton Country Park with its Animal Park, walled garden, maze, and greenhouse. Go for walks along the seafront and the beach, and visit places like Jubilee Park in Waterlooville; The Sustainability Centre; and The Queen Elizabeth Country Park. Book now and look forward to flying a kite on Butser Hill and visiting the Heath at Petersfield to see the different types of water fowl. Choose where to go, how to get there, plan how much time you need, what to take with you, and how to keep safe.

Get to grips with photography

Get to know your chosen device and enjoy the wonderful world of photography. On this course you will learn all about using your device - from turning it on, focussing the lens, understanding and changing the settings, to taking the picture.
